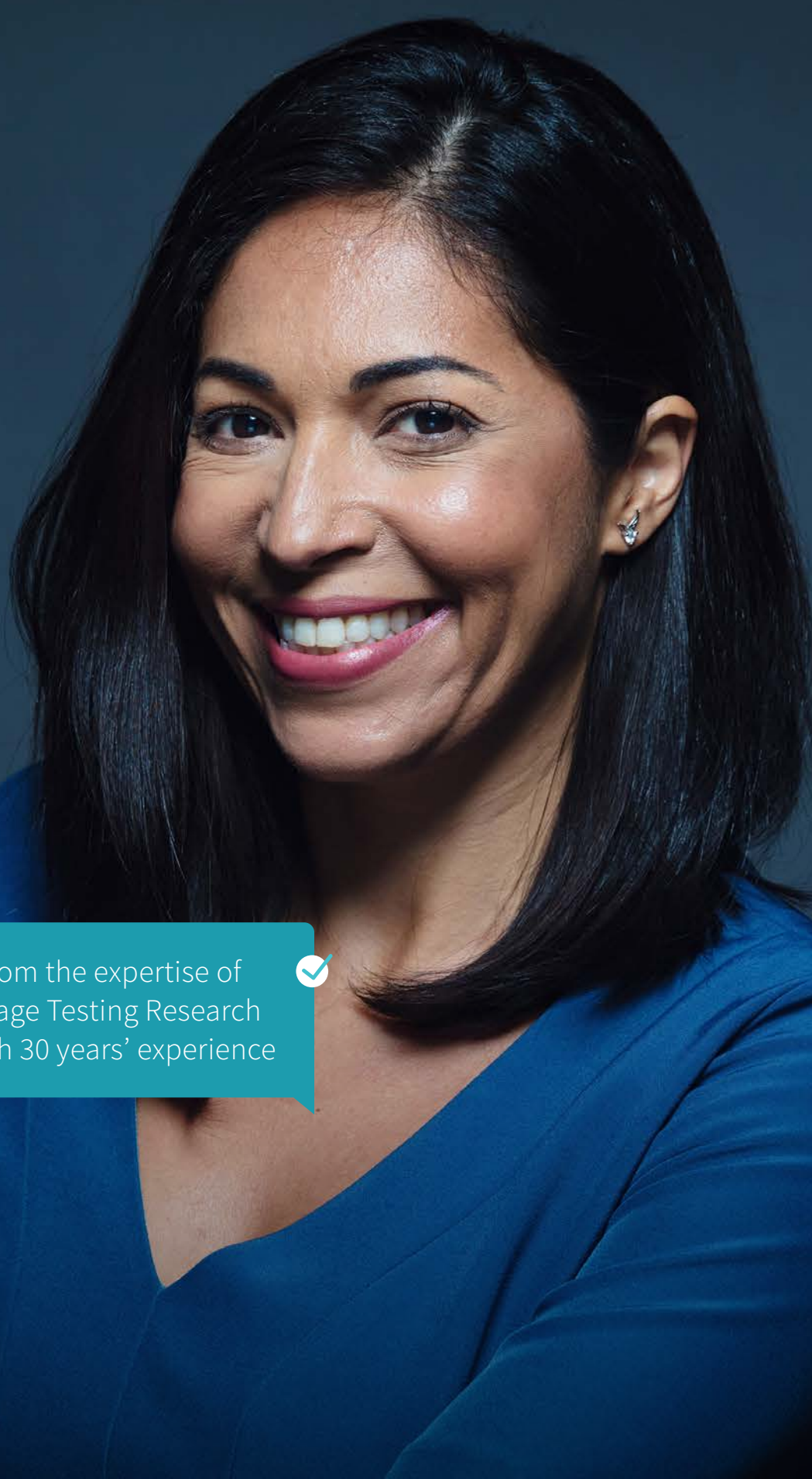

Developed by the Language Testing Research Centre, this course has been designed for qualified language teachers and professionals who deliver language assessments such as:

- Teachers of ELICOS (English Language Intensive Courses for Overseas Students) programs,
- Teachers of TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) programs,
- Teachers of EAL (English as an Additional Language) programs; and
- Staff in organisations that conduct language testing.

What are the benefits?

Language assessment is a growing field worldwide, and graduates of this course will be regarded as highly-trained specialists who will be ideal candidates for a multitude of international career opportunities.

We've designed this course to improve the standard of language assessment literacy globally. Students completing the professional certificate will:

- Acquire skills in creating, delivering and evaluating language tests; and
- Develop the capability to enhance the day-to-day running of language programs to improve student outcomes.

What will I learn?

The Professional Certificate in Language Assessment has been devised to offer a practical focus on providing language assessment in real-life educational contexts and allow practitioners to evaluate the efficacy of their existing assessments. This course will help you deliver more reliable and meaningful results for students, and on completion you will have gained:

- Knowledge of fundamental concepts and principles in language testing
- Practical experience in developing and evaluating assessments for second and foreign language learners; and
- Background knowledge of the key debates in second language assessment and testing.

You'll also learn about the key types of language assessments which promote learning, and have an opportunity to develop your own tests, then receive feedback from your tutors and peers.

Core subjects		Points
General Concepts in Language Assessment	In this subject, students are introduced to the general concepts of language assessment and examine the assessment of listening, reading, speaking and writing as well as integrated skills in detail in both theory and practice. Includes general principles of test development, test purposes, writing of test specifications, test items and test tasks. Participants are also introduced to the topic of validity in language assessment and will learn some basic skills in statistical analysis of test data.	12.5
Language Assessment for Learning	Students are introduced to the main concepts of learning-orientated assessment. This subject explores the differences between learning-oriented assessment and other language assessments. Participants will learn key types of language assessments that promote learning and will have an opportunity to learn how to evaluate learning-oriented language assessments and assessment systems.	12.5

Entry requirements

To apply for the Professional Certificate in Language Assessment, applicants must have:

- An undergraduate degree or equivalent or;
- At least 5 years' worth of full-time documented relevant professional experience.

Meeting these requirements makes you eligible for selection but does not guarantee selection. In ranking applications, the Selection Committee will consider:

- Prior academic performance; and
- Professional work experience.

The Selection Committee may seek further information to clarify any aspect of an application in accordance with the Academic Board rules on the use of selection instruments.

Students taking the course from overseas are not required to have an international student visa.

Applicants are required to satisfy the University's English language requirements for postgraduate courses. For those applicants seeking to meet these requirements by one of the standard tests approved by the Academic Board, **performance band 6.5** is required.
