Entry requirements

To be considered for entry, you must have completed either:

- A four-year undergraduate degree in a related area, or equivalent; or
- A three-year undergraduate degree and at least 50 credit points, or equivalent, of graduate study in a related area; or

- A three-year undergraduate degree in a cognate area and at least two years of documented, relevant professional experience in tertiary education management, or equivalent;

AND

- Have current employment in the tertiary education sector; and
- Employer support to participate.

Meeting these entry requirements does not guarantee selection. In ranking applications, the Selection Committee will consider:

- Prior academic performance; and
- Professional experience.
