Who is this course for?

This course has been designed for professionals from a wide range of roles within various sectors including, information technology, engineering, healthcare, supply and distribution, advanced manufacturing and professional services (legal services, financial services, consultancies etc.)

The 16-week Professional Certificate in Workplace Leadership will help you to develop the foundations of your leadership skills, while solidifying and enhancing the leadership skills you have already acquired.

- Understand your role and personal ability to effect practice of leadership within your teams, departments and broader organisations
- Demonstrate the ability to coach and support others to maximise their workplace performance
- Design a personal leadership development plan
- Apply new skills and knowledge in the workplace.

Subject summaries

Subjects	Points	
<p>Foundations of Leadership</p>	<p>This subject investigates what leadership is, why it is important and analyses the factors that impact upon workplace leadership and the impacts leadership has in an organisational context.</p> <p>As a student, you'll undertake assessment and reflective exercises to help you gain insights into your own leadership values, strengths and weaknesses. You'll use these to create a personal leadership development plan.</p> <p>You'll also develop fundamental leadership skills such as collaboration and teamwork, relationship building, listening and communication, as well as self-reflection.</p> <p>This subject provides the foundation for the second subject in the course, Leadership in Practice.</p>	<p>12.5</p>
<p>Leadership in Practice</p>	<p>In this subject you'll learn and apply more advanced knowledge and skills. You'll be encouraged to exercise and foster leadership within more complex organisational environments and systems. You'll undertake collaborative leadership challenges, developing your systems and strategic thinking, as well as your abilities as a decision maker, coach and supporter of colleagues.</p> <p>Drawing on the individual leadership development plan you developed in Foundations of Leadership, you'll also devise and implement an intervention case study for your own workplace leadership scenario.</p>	<p>12.5</p>

Entry requirements

In order to be considered for entry, you must have completed:

- An undergraduate degree or equivalent AND
- One year of documented relevant post graduation professional experience, which demonstrates the capacity to undertake the course successfully.

Meeting these requirements does not guarantee selection.

In ranking applications, the Selection Committee will consider:

- Prior academic performance; and
- Relevant post- graduation professional experience

The Selection Committee may seek further information to clarify any aspect of an application with the above criteria.

Applicants are required to satisfy the university's English language requirements for graduate courses. For those applicants seeking to meet these requirements by one of the standard tests approved by the Academic Board, **performance band 6.5** is required.

Course fees are the same for both domestic and international students.

Fees are paid on a per subject basis each term, and total course fees are not required to be paid up-front.

The fees listed are the indicative costs for 2017*. The University reviews fees annually. The indicative total course fee is based on typical subject enrolments, and includes an indexation of 5 per cent per annum.

The fees you pay for graduate study will vary depending on the type of enrolment or place you are offered. If you are an Australian Citizen or Permanent Humanitarian Visa holder, you may be eligible for financial assistance from the Australian Government. You may be eligible for the government loan scheme known as FEE-HELP, which isn't normally the case for leadership and executive programs.
